



Super Safety Tips


 The NFPA recommends installing both ionization and photoelectric smoke alarms in the home for maximum protection.

Install smoke alarms 10 feet away from major appliances.


 Install smoke and carbon monoxide alarms on every level and in every bedroom. Fire Extinguishers are also recommended on every level of your home.

• If you have a multi-story home, have an escape ladder.
