

Teatime Bingo Game

Age Recommendation & Safety Note

Recommended Age: This Tea Party Bingo game is best suited for ages 4 and up. Younger children can play with adult assistance.

How to Use Your Tea Party Bingo Printable

Getting started is quick and fun!

1. **Print the Game Pages:** Print all 12 bingo cards and the 16 calling cards. For best results, use white cardstock so the cards are sturdy and easy to handle. Use your printers best ink setting for the brightest colors. Colors will vary depending on the printer you own.
2. **Cut Out the Calling Cards:** Carefully cut apart the 16 calling cards. These will be used to call out each bingo item during the game.
3. **Prepare Your Game (Optional but Recommended)**
To make your bingo set last longer, laminate the bingo cards and calling cards after printing. This allows you to reuse them again and again—perfect for future tea parties! Use a corner rounder punch or scissor to trim and remove the sharp corners if laminated.
4. **Choose a Caller:** Pick one person to be the caller. This person will draw and announce the calling cards one at a time.
5. **Play the Game:** Give each player a bingo card and something to mark their spaces, such as circles cut from cardstock or laminated paper markers. The caller draws a card and announces it. Players mark the matching image on their card if they have it.
6. **Winning the Game:** The first player to complete a row (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal) calls out “Bingo!” and wins the round.
7. **Keep the Fun Going:** Shuffle the calling cards and play as many rounds as you like!

Make it extra fun by offering a small prize to each winner! Here are a few easy ideas:

- A cute teacup or mug
- Individually wrapped tea bags or a small tea sampler
- Homemade cookies or tea party treats
- Mini jars of jam or honey
- Pretty napkins or a small kitchen towel
- A simple gift card (tea shop or bakery)

Keep it simple—something small and thoughtful is all you need to make the game feel special!
